However, this does not exclude the presence of negligible traces due to among other things impurities in the components supplied by external parties.

FM27 contains epoxyprene as one of the raw materials, which is not a natural rubber latex but synthetically synthesized with using natural rubber as starting material.

FDA RECOMMENDATION:

Since last year, the FDA does not accept a "latex free" labelling for FM27 anymore and proposes following labelling to be used:

"May contain natural rubber latex which may cause allergic reactions in latex sensitive individuals."
