

CERTIFICATE OF GMP COMPLIANCE

We certify herewith

that the company DSM Nutritional Products AG, Wurmisweg 576, 4303 Kaiseraugst with its site DSM Nutritional Products AG, Zweigniederlassung Werk Sisseln, Hauptstrasse 4, 4334 Sisseln, Switzerland, has been duly authorized to manufacture and distribute active pharmaceutical ingredients (APIs) as well investigational APIs, the manufacturing licence and including following types of active pharmaceutical ingredients:

- APIs produced aseptically
- APIs terminally sterilised
- highly active or sensitising APIs such as cephalosporins, cytostatics and others

that the company is keeping the required level for good practices in the manufacture of active pharmaceutical ingredients according to the Swiss regulations in force. GMP certificates: no expiry date

Swissmedic, Swiss Agency for Therapeutic Products may issue GMP certificates on manufacturers of medicinal products and/or active pharmaceutical ingredients located in Switzerland.

We hereby confirm that there is no expiry date on these GMP certificates. These certificates are valid as long as no amendments to the corresponding establishment license on which a GMP certificate is based have been made. These certificates always contain two dates: the date of the last inspection and the date of issue of the certificate. The GMP certificate reflects the status of the manufacturing site at the time of the inspection and should not be relied upon to reflect the compliance status if more than three years have elapsed since the date of that inspection, after which time the issuing authority should be consulted.
